

Family law Advice line volunteers Rights of Women



We are currently seeking qualified women solicitor, barrister or legal executive volunteers to provide legal advice on our free evening or day time family law advice lines based in central London.

Rights of Women is a registered charity which aims to increase women's understanding of their legal rights and improve their access to justice.

Volunteers must hold a full practising certificate and have a specialism in family law. The volunteers will be provided with advice line skills training and we ask for a minimum commitment of one advice session each month. Each advice session lasts 2 hours.
